

Regulations Swimming Pool de Kurenpolder 2026

1. It is prohibited to be in the swimming pool or the associated areas outside the established opening hours, unless with the permission of the pool staff.
2. All materials belonging to the pool may only be used with the permission of the pool staff.
3. Clothes and other belongings can be stored in the designated lockable lockers. They can also be hung in the shared changing rooms. Kurenpolder Recreatie or the pool staff are not liable for lost or damaged property of visitors.
4. Valuables can be stored in the lockers in the changing room.
5. Visitors and guests may not remain unnecessarily in or near the changing rooms or the communal changing areas.
6. Guests, visitors, supervisors, and parents may only enter the swimming pool barefoot or wearing clean athletic shoes that have not been used outdoors. To prevent contamination, blue safety covers are available in the changing room.
7. Smoking is prohibited in all areas of the main building.
8. Glassware is not permitted anywhere on the property.
9. All waste must be deposited in the designated bins.
10. Swimmers must shower before swimming.
11. Only swimwear is allowed in the water. T-shirts, hats, underwear, long pants, etc. are not permitted.
12. Every visitor is required to show their entrance ticket or ID card at the reception and at the request of the pool staff.
13. The slide and other equipment and facilities must be used according to regulations. It is not permitted to stop or remain seated above or in the course of the slide. The user must not endanger their own safety or that of other users.
14. During recreational swimming, the management cannot guarantee that every user will have access to all facilities or equipment in the pool at all times. For safety reasons, and to prevent nuisance or inconvenience to other visitors or users, staff is authorized to disable equipment.
15. During recreational swimming, children without a valid swimming certificate are MANDATORY to wear proper swimming armbands or an easy-swim. They may only swim in deep water accompanied by an adult. If, in the opinion of the supervisor, this measure does not provide sufficient safety, access may be denied.
16. Instructions from the pool staff must be strictly followed.
17. Only beach balls are allowed, as long as the crowds allow it; all other balls are not allowed.
18. Diving and bombing are prohibited in the entire pool.
19. In the event of irregularities or misconduct by visitors and/or tenants, the pool staff is entitled to remove the visitors and/or tenants in question from the pool and deny them access to the facility.
20. It is strictly forbidden to operate any technical installation and to be in areas that are not intended for visitors.
21. Any damage to the accommodation and/or its associated equipment, which in the opinion of the pool staff is caused by or as a result of incorrect and unauthorized use, must be compensated by the user or renter upon first request.
22. Neither De Kurenpolder Recreatie swimming pool nor the pool staff can be held liable in any way for any damage or injury caused by any coincidence or accident to the user or renter, their guests or members, or persons admitted with their consent, or their property.
23. The De Kurenpolder Recreational Swimming Pool has a camera surveillance system. If there are grounds for doing so, the recorded footage can be used as evidence.
24. In all cases not provided for in these General Rules, the management of De Kurenpolder recreation will decide
